


These are actual medical warnings about the non-prescription pain killer ibuprofen.

People who take nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs) (other than aspirin) such as ibuprofen may have a higher risk of having a heart attack or a stroke than people who do not take these medications.

Some side effects can be serious. If you experience any of the following symptoms, call your doctor immediately:

Do not take any more ibuprofen until you speak to your doctor.



shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
swelling of the abdomen, feet, ankles, or lower legs
unexplained weight gain
fever
blisters
rash
itching
hives
difficulty breathing or swallowing
hoarseness
excessive tiredness
pain in the upper right part of the stomach
nausea
loss of appetite
yellowing of the skin or eyes
flu-like symptoms
pale skin
fast heartbeat
cloudy, discolored, or bloody urine
back pain
difficult or painful urination
red or painful eyes
stiff neck
headache
confusion
aggression

If you experience any of the following symptoms, stop taking ibuprofen and call your doctor: stomach pain, heartburn, vomit that is bloody or looks like coffee grounds, blood in the stool, or black and tarry stools.
